## INDIAN ECONOMY

- 🇮🇳 \$ 2.25 Trillion GDP Economy Today- *7th Largest in Nominal Terms.*
- 🇮🇳 8.4% CAGR GDP Growth rate from 1991-2017.
- 🇮🇳 \$ 8.7 Trillion GDP in PPP terms- *3<sup>rd</sup> Largest in the World.*
- 🇮🇳 India is expected to be the fastest growing economy touching a GDP of 7.25 trillion by 2030.
- 🇮🇳 India's robust economic growth and rising household incomes are expected to increase consumer spending to US\$ 3.6 trillion by 2020.

## NEW AGE ASPIRATIONS

- 2<sup>nd</sup> largest Internet users base with 462 million Internet users. By 2020, India will have 700 million broadband users.
- In 2016, India ranked 39th among the world's most competitive economies, up 16 places from previous year.
- In the year ending 2015-16, India was the 3rd largest startup ecosystem. At present there are 26000 start ups, US\$ 135 bn invested in IT Industry.

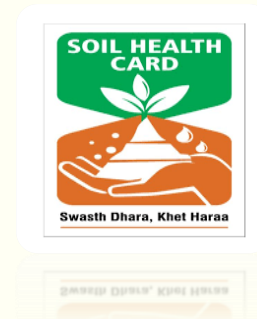
## INVESTMENTS DESTINATION

- India's robust economic growth and rising household incomes are expected to increase consumer spending to US\$ 3.6 trillion by 2020.

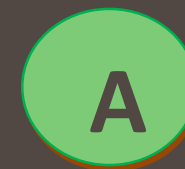

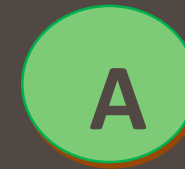
